Recycling & reuse information

Items collected during the verge collection are taken to a sorting facility to ensure as much as possible is recovered and recycled.

Please assess all items for recycling and reuse options before putting them out for collection.

If it works someone could use it! Have you tried:

- Contacting your **local charity**?
- **Advertising the item** for sale or for free on Gumtree.com.au?
- Posting on Facebook Market Place or other social media platforms to sell or give away the item?

The City offers two verge collections annually - the next will be in the second half of the year. Details will be available on the website.



How to set out your waste

GENERAL WASTE

Chairs, sofas, toys, cardboard, furniture etc

WHITE GOODS

Stoves, freezers, refrigerators, etc (Remove doors from fridges and freezers). Cut all power cables from appliances.

ELECTRONIC WASTE

Televisions, computers, printers, mobile phones, DVD & CD players, VCRs and Hi-Fi Equipment. Cut all power cables from devices.

MATTRESSES

Mattresses only.

GARDEN WASTE

Tree and shrub prunings up to 15m in length and up to 30cm in diameter, lawn clippings & leaves in boxes or bags.

Collection will commence the week beginning
Monday 18 March 2024

Do not place your waste out on the verge until Saturday 16 March – the weekend before the collection service begins AND before 6am on Monday 18 March

This is the second of two verge collections in the 2023/24 financial year.
Please note the verge collection service is available to residential properties only

TO MAKE COLLECTION EASIER, please follow these simple steps

- Separate electronic waste, whitegoods and garden waste into separate piles
- Neatly place items on the street verge
- Trim tree branches/prunings to a maximum length of 1.5m. Larger branches will NOT be removed
- Items should be of a maximum weight that is easily handled by two people
- Use boxes or bags for lawn clippings, cuttings and leaves
- Ensure items do not obstruct the footpath or your normal bin service

WHAT YOU CAN DO with the items we will not remove

These items can include (but are not limited to) construction waste (cement, bricks, rubble, sand), tyres, vehicle parts and motor oil.

Note: fees may apply to some items so please contact the facility before you visit for the most up-to-date information.

Whitegoods*

Stoves, freezers, refrigerators, etc
Remove all doors



Electronic waste*

Televisions, computers, printers, mobile phones, DVD & CD Players, VCRs, and Hi-Fi Equipment

*Please cut/remove all power cables from electrical items prior to placing in the verge.



Old Furniture and mattresses



Garden waste

Tree and shrub prunings up to 1.5m in length and up to 30cm in diameter, lawn clippings & leaves in boxes or bags

Note: Garden waste and mattresses are collected separately to be recycled. Other items are sent to the recycling sorting facility.

DO NOT place any of these items out for collection.
They WILL NOT be removed.

Note: Verge collection is not available to commercial premises.
