That the Design Advisory Committee, having considered the design for the proposed expansion of St Catherine's College including the addition of 53 student accommodation units, refurbished student learning centre, associated facilities and an under-croft car parking area at 2 (Lot 17) Park Road, Crawley:-

- 1. supports the overall design and aesthetic quality of the development, recognising that consideration has been given to presenting a restrained approach to unifying the old and the new buildings, integrating the form and materials with the architectural language of the existing development on the site while also ensuring the design is sensitive to its purpose;
- 2. Considers that the proposed landscaping together with the existing trees along the street frontage will improve the new building's presentation to the street, however, states a preference for the existing fire tanks to be relocated to another part of the site, away from the street front.
- 3. Queries the value of the awning covering the western side of the under-croft car park as an acoustic device and seeks a better resolved and improved architectural outcome if the awning is retained.

Item 6.2 108 (Lots 58, 59, 60, F9 and F10) St Georges Terrace, Perth – Request for Minor Plot Ratio Bonus to Change the Use of Office Lobby to Café Dining Area

That the Design Advisory Committee, having considered the awarding of a minor plot ratio bonus of 0.4% or 97m² of plot ratio floor area for the change of use of a portion of the office tower lobby to a café dining area at 108 (Lot 58, 59, 60, F9 and F10) St Georges Terrace, Perth, supports the proposal, noting that the additional plot ratio will enable a use that promotes pedestrian interest and the activation of what is currently a sparse lobby space, satisfying the requirements of clause 28(6) of City Planning Scheme No. 2.

Biophilic Design

Mr Kerr requested an update on the Biophilic Design Policy. The City Architect advised that it was being review by Sustainability and by City Design for inclusion in the revised City Design Guidelines.

The City Architect was a panellist at a recent CUSP Biophilic Design seminar at which he stressed the need to tailor biophilic outcomes to the situation. For instance, Perth has more open space that European cities and perhaps access to fresh air in the workplace might be a better target than expensive and difficult to maintain green roofs.
