

Bus Stops and Shelters

Placement and Setout of Tactiles at Bus Shelters

TYPICAL BUS STOP AND TACTILE PAVERS WITH BUS SHELTER

Note

Bus shelters should be located where there is a need for shelter from sun, rain and/or wind, for passengers waiting for or alighting from buses.

They should be positioned:

- a minimum of 600mm from overhang to the road edge;
- to avoid damage to existing services and/or tree
- to avoid affecting 'line of sight' for vehicles entering traffic from adjacent cross-overs (where applicable);
- * street furniture should be placed no closer than 1600mm from the shelter structure and the bus information board:
- * refer to City of Perth Design and Construction Notes Book 100 drawing 101.04, for preferred kerb height detail.
