- 1. Fabric Banners and Flags: we recommend using a heavy weight trilobal cloth. Printing on trilobal, ink may need to be tested and set to penetrate the cloth material.
- 2. Vinyl Banners: must use a heavy duty vinyl material, to guard against strong winds.
- 3. All banners and flags: must be produced to withstand wind speeds of a minimum 110 km/h.
- 4. Printing should be run at a high pass.
- 5. All banners and flags must include a Design Reference/Site Key, including the relevant site code and design number (where 2 or more designs are in use), in the top left corner of the each banner and flag.
- 6. It is recommended to produce 1-3 spares per site, excluding S1: 901.09 Street-Wide Vinyl Banner.
- 7. Fabric Banners and Flags: folded in groups of 4, with the Design Reference/Site Key at the top.
- 8. Vinyl Banners: rolled individually or up-to 4 per roll, with the Design Reference/Site Key at the top.
