## Guide for venue capacity determination

The maximum number of persons that may be accommodated in a public building will be determined using the below table in conjunction with additional factors such as site layout and event management measures. Please note that for less than 0.5 m2 per person you will be required to contact the Department of Health for approval.

## Capacity Table - Health (Public Buildings) Regulations 1992

Area per person according to use [Reg. 7(1)]	Metres squared per person allowed:
Type of use:	— m² per person
Licensed premises having a floor area of 850 m <sup>2</sup> or less	0.85
Spectator stand, audience viewing area:  — bench seating	450 mm/person wide x 750 mm deep (minimum)
— fixed seating	450 mm/person wide (min)
— seating not fixed	1
<ul> <li>standing viewing area</li> </ul>	0.5
Skating rink, based on rink area	1.5
Exhibition Area	4
Auditorium/Hall	1

<sup>\*</sup>Please note under Health Legislation the City is unable to approve capacity of less than 0.5m2 per person. Please contact the Department of Health regarding exemptions.
