SmartRider cards can be purchased from participating newsagencies or major train and bus stations in Perth City. SmartRider is an electronic prepaid ticketing system using a tag on/tag off approach that deducts the fare from the stored value on the card.

Buses

Central Area Transit (CAT) buses provide a free, frequent and accessible bus service in the city. The operating routes, red, yellow, green and blue (Map 1). CAT timetables are available from the Transperth website www.transperth.wa.gov.au

Perth City is home to the Perth Busport. The Busport can be accessed by three entrances through either, Yagan Square (MAP M5), Kings Square (MAP K5) and Queen Street (MAP L5).

Free Transit Zone

Perth City has a Free Transit Zone (FTZ) for buses and a SmartRider free Transit Zone for trains. The FTZ allows travel on all trains and buses within the City of Perth boundaries, without paying a fare.

Taxi User Subsidy Scheme

Under the Taxi User Subsidy Scheme (TUSS), eligible members, unless placed in the temporary category, will be granted membership for an initial five year period. Members are provided with a membership card and a book of vouchers. The vouchers can be used in all taxis including the multi-purpose taxis (MPT) which are wheelchair accessible.

ACROD Parking Program

The ACROD Parking Program supports Western Australians with a severe walking restriction to access the community.

ACROD Parking Permits are free. The cost of the permit is funded by the Government of Western Australia.

City of Perth real time parking information

Use the City of Perth's Bay Availability to find an available parking space before you begin your journey. Parking availability is available in real time. You can access the Bay Availability via the City of Perth's Parking webpage or by downloading the City of Perth's Parking app.

City of Perth Parking app – The parking app available for Apple and Android devices. The app will enable you to view available bays and opening times at City of Perth Car Parks. The App also allows you to locate car parks closest to your city destination, set a parking timer reminder for when your parking is due to expire and even set the location of where you're parked. Plus, stay up to date with special CPP parking discounts and promotions. The app is available via the Apple App Store or Google Play.

On-street parking

The City of Perth provides parking concession on-street (kerbside) for people with accessibility requirements who hold a valid ACROD parking permit.

Kerbside parking bays are on-street parking bays controlled by green permissive parking signs e.g. 1/4 P, 1P, 2P.

There are three sign types:

1. No cost - Time restricted (General Bays)

In non-ticketed parking areas, a vehicle displaying a valid ACROD Parking Permit in a time restricted parking bay may park for:

- If the time limit indicated on the parking sign is under 30 minutes (1/2 P). The vehicle can only park for 30 minutes (1/2 P);
- If the time limit indicated on the parking sign is between 30 (1/2P) and 60 minutes (1P). The vehicle can park for two hours; and
- If the time limit indicated on the parking sign is over 60 minutes. The vehicle can park for twice the time specified on the parking signs. For example, if the sign indicates two hour parking (2P), permit holders are allowed to park for four hours at no cost.

2. Time restricted fee payable (General Bays)

A vehicle displaying a valid ACROD permit in a time restricted parking bay where a fee is payable, must pay the minimum applicable fee and if required, fees for additional parking time. After the purchased time expires, the vehicle may park for twice the time paid for, up to a maximum of twice the time specified for that bay. For example, in a bay marked one hour (1P), the permit holder can pay for one hour and park for two hours.

3. Time restricted fee payable

Parking in a time restricted ACROD bay is limited to the period stated on the sign. Fees apply.

Please note: Concessions do not apply to restricted parking areas such as Clearways, Loading Zones, Bus Zones, Taxi Zones.

City of Perth Car Parks

City of Perth car parks provide up to two hours free parking for valid ACROD permit holders. ACROD permit holders can park in both ACROD allocated bays and non-ACROD allocated bays.

Parking Meter Car Parks

In a 'Pay and Display' car park which is unstaffed i.e. Queens Garden, ACROD permit holders are required to purchase a ticket and pay for minimum of one hour. This ticket must be displayed on the dashboard of the vehicle. The ticket will be valid for an additional two hours after the expiry time.





Boom Gate Car Parks (when staff are on duty)

When parking in a car park which issues a ticket at the entry of a boomgate, ACROD permit holders must pay for a minimum of one hour and can park for an additional two hours free. ACROD permit holders can redeem their free parking by visiting the Customer Service Office prior to exiting the car park (the Customer Service Offices are located at the exit of the car park). The Customer Service Officer will need to sight the ACROD permit and will also collect any monies owing.

If the carpark is not attended, permit holders can redeem their free two hours by accessing the intercom button on the parking machines. City of Perth staff will advise permit holders to display their permit via the CCTV camera.

Alternatively, permit holders can obtain a refund for the free two hours by sending their receipt and a legible copy of their permit to info@cityofperth.wa.gov.au or to Council House, GPO Box C120, Perth WA 6839 (there is no official document that needs to be completed to receive a refund).

Permit holders do not need to redeem their concessions individually; they may retain their receipts and several at once.

Boom Gate Car Parks (when staff are not on duty)
