





Who should I call?

If you've seen an incident in the city, report it. City of Perth and WA Police take these calls seriously and want your help in stamping out criminal and antisocial behaviour. If you need to report something, call the relevant number below.

Life threatening emergencies

If there is a fire, or if someone is severely injured or in distress, **call 000.**

Criminal activity

Police 131 444

Call the police if you are concerned for the immediate safety of yourself or others. Police work with Citywatch to find and prosecute offenders.

CCTV live incidents

The City of Perth has more than 400 cameras keeping an eye on the streets 24 hours a day. If you see a situation occurring and there is a camera close by, Citywatch may be able to monitor the event.
