CP20.3 FOOTPATHS – UPGRADING OF

POLICY OBJECTIVE

To achieve a uniform approach in the material used when upgrading footpaths under the control of the City of Perth.

POLICY STATEMENT

Footpaths within the City of Perth, depending upon their location, as indicated below, shall be constructed of uniform materials in order to give continuity of surface and appearance.

Footpaths within the City of Perth will be upgraded in accordance with the following standards:

Central Business District and Residential Areas Generally

- 1. Subject to clause 2 below, 400mm x 400mm x 60mm exposed aggregate slabs will be used in the Central Business District and Residential Areas generally.
- Footpaths in parts of the Central Business District may be upgraded to granite or feature paving in accordance with the principles contained within the Council's Urban Design Framework

West Perth

Footpaths and verge treatments in West Perth will be in accordance with the "West Perth Road Reserve Study" dated October 1985 (TRIM Reference P1702449-01).
