**Closures and restrictions**

- On 26 January 2024 the area marked in yellow is closed to vessels from 4pm – 4:30pm, 5pm – 5:30pm, 6pm – 6:30pm, 7pm – 7:30pm and 8pm – 9pm.
- During the above times vessels will not be permitted to transit, anchor or moor within the closed water area.
- Outside the above times there will be a 150 metre moving exclusion zone around the three fireworks barges, including whilst transiting, from 8am on Friday 26 January until sunrise on Saturday 27 January 2024.
- Swimming is not permitted in the closed water area.
- An 8 knot speed limit will be in place for all of Perth Water from 8am on Friday 26 January until sunrise on Saturday 27 January 2024.
- Anchoring is permitted in Perth Water outside of the closed water area and navigable channels.
- Skippers navigating the area should be aware of the available water depth and monitor their radio (27Mhz channel 88 and VHF channels 9 and 16).
- There is a 10 knot speed limit between sunset and sunrise in open speed areas.
